- Take responsibility for promoting and safeguarding the welfare of children and young people within the school.
- Contribute to curriculum development that is in line with Trust approach and values.





- Coordinate and manage an effective learning environment for all pupils which is positive, safe, stimulating and promotes the wellbeing of all pupils.
- Ensure the effective and efficient use of any support staff who are supporting teaching and learning in the classroom.
- Set regular opportunities for home learning.
- Implement and follow Trust and school policies and procedures.
- Maintain appropriate records and provide accurate information on pupil progress and other relevant matters as required by the school.
- To assess, record and report on attendance, progress, development and attainment of pupils.
- Provide feedback to pupils work in line with school policy and use this to inform future planning and teaching.
- Report to parents on the development, progress and attainment of pupils.
- To take part in the school's professional development programme by participating in arrangements and opportunities for continuous professional development.
- Any other duties as deemed necessary.
